BEER BOARD

NOVEMBER 14, 2022

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BMA) met as the Jonesborough Beer Board on Monday, November 14, 2022, at 7:00 p.m., at Town Hall, 123 Boone Street, Jonesborough, TN.

Present for the meeting was Mayor Chuck Vest, Alderman Terry Countermine, Alderman Adam Dickson, and Alderman Kelly Wolfe. Absent was Alderman Virginia Causey. Also present were: Town Administrator Glenn Rosenoff, Town Recorder Robert Anderson, Operations Manager Craig Ford, and Town Attorney Jim Wheeler.

Mayor Vest called the meeting to order and asked if there was a representative present in regard to the application for an On-Premise Beer License for East TN Hemp Company. Tara and D.W. Cooper, 109 East Main Street, Jonesborough, TN, addressed the Beer Board. Mr. Cooper said that since the Barrel House had to close due to fire related damage, they decided to establish a restaurant within their current business space and want to serve alcoholic beverages. Mr. Cooper said they have obtained a Liquor-By-the-Drink permit from the TN Alcoholic Beverage Commission and are asked for an on-premise beer license from the Town. Town Administrator Glenn Rosenoff said the Cooper's application for an on-premise beer license is complete and the Police Department has conducted several background checks as part of the application process and are waiting for the results. Mr. Rosenoff said his recommendation is to approve the on-premise beer license as presented subject to the background check(s) coming back with no bad record.

Mayor Vest asked the Aldermen if they had any questions or comments. There being none, Alderman Countermine made the motion the approve the on-premise beer application for East TN Hemp Company, Tara and D.W. Cooper, 109 East Main Street, Jonesborough, TN, with the recommendation of the Town Administrator subject to the

background check(s) coming back with no ba and duly passed.	d record, seconded by Alderman Wolfe,
