BEER BOARD

JUNE 13, 2022

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BMA) met as the Jonesborough Beer Board on Monday, June 13, 2022, at 7:00 p.m., at Town Hall, 123 Boone Street, Jonesborough, TN.

Mayor Vest called the meeting to order and said the only item for consideration was an application for an Off-Premise Beer Permit for Weigel's #99, 152 Headtown Road, Jonesborough, TN. Mayor Vest asked if there was anyone in attendance to present this request. Doug Yawberry, representing Weigel's, 3100 Weigel Lane, Powell, TN, addressed the Board, stating they have just opened the new store and they would like to have the privilege to be able sell beer and wine, and they understand as an organization that it is a privilege. Mr. Yawberry said that Weigel's does a lot of things to make sure that they do not sell to underage consumers whether it be beer or cigarettes or anything that is age restricted. Doug Yawberry said they have registers that a birthdate has to be inputted or they can scan a driver's license, and if a customer is not of age, it automatically cancels the sell. Mr. Yawberry said they do their own internal compliance checks within their organization, and they go out every 30 to 45 days at all their locations to make sure that they are not selling to underage consumers. He said before any of their employees can sell alcohol at one of their stores they go through extensive training and also an alcohol training program in which they have to be certified. Doug Yawberry said Weigel's does a lot to make sure they are good corporate Mayor Vest welcomed Weigel's to Jonesborough. Mayor Vest asked the Aldermen if they had any comments. Town Administrator Glenn Rosenoff said the store looks great and we are happy to have Weigel's as partners in Jonesborough. Attorney Wheeler said there is one thing that needs to be clarified and he does not think there is any problem with this, but the application that was used is an On-Premises Beer License application. Mr. Wheeler said the information is all the same, but it does need to be clarified this application is for an Off-Premises Beer License. There being no further discussion, Alderman Countermine made the motion to approve the Off-Premise
