Thank you for your interest in this year's Jonesborough Christmas Parade. We are happy for your participation and we want to make this the most successful and beautiful Christmas parade yet!! This year's parade will take place on Saturday, December 11th at 6pm featuring the theme "Christmas in the South".

As it is a night parade, we would be happy to see the <u>incorporation of music (live or not) as well as lights</u> with each float/entry. Prizes for the parade are also judged around these elements. In addition, the lights make quite a spectacular scene going down Main Street in the dark. We will provide the Santa at the end of the parade and there are <u>no other Santas allowed in the parade</u>. The Town of Jonesborough encourages you to gather family, friends, coworkers and community groups to celebrate the spirit of the holidays. Be festive and creative while exhibiting community pride in the Jonesborough Christmas Parade.

Here are a few suggestions for decorating your entry:

General Guidelines

Create festive holiday themes. If using a business sponsor, please make sure their name or logo does not dominate the decorations or theme of your entry. If you are planning to have electrically amplified sound, please make sure it doesn't overpower other parade entries or announcers. We prohibit any sales or marketing efforts by parade participants for membership or products.

Floats:

Use a flatbed trailer or truck for your base. Use lightweight materials for your construction such as wood, cardboard, styrofoam, or paper machete. You can utilize a small generator to power lights to add brilliance. If your float is going to carry people, make sure they have something to hold onto to prevent them from falling while the float is in motion.

Walking Groups:

You can utilize cardboard to make signs for decoration or cutouts for people to carry. You can use multiple helium filled balloons to float a sign or appropriate decorations for people to pull along with strings. Small, battery operated blinking and/or colored lights can help enhance the decorations. You can use wagons or lightweight pull-along platforms.


Theme Ideas:

Here are some keywords that may help you get an idea for your entry: colors, creative use of lights, tree, reindeer, music, stars, anything Holiday related.

Animal Entries:

All parade entries with animals must have a plan for the removal of animal waste because we have so many walking entries including children. Horses are required to wear proper gear that guarantees the parade route will stay clear of horse droppings.

Please distribute all parade information to each participant in your entry Put your thinking caps on and start those creative juices flowing!!

Parade Award Categories

This year participants in the Jonesborough Christmas Parade will be eligible for several awards based on the following categories. Judging will go on during the parade this year as the judges will be observing entrants throughout the parade. Winners will be notified upon the decisions of the judges and will be listed in the Herald and Tribune newspaper.

Eagle Award

Given to the float judged to be the best overall float entry. Judging factors include conformance with the parade theme, creativity, design, costumes, etc. This award will be \$200.00.

Mayor's Award

Given to the float judged to be the best representation of the Town of Jonesborough. Judging factors include conformance to the theme, use of lights and music, and capturing the essence of the community of Jonesborough. This award will be \$150.00.

Schubert Club Award

Given to the float judged to be the best representation of music in the Town of Jonesborough. Judging factors include conformance to the theme, costume, design, music, creativity, etc. This award will be \$100.00.

Jonesborough Kiwanis Award

Given to the float that best represents children or children's issues. Judging factors will be conformance to the theme, representation of children's events or issues, creativity and costumes. This award will be \$100.00

Jonesborough Food Pantry Award

This award will be given to the entry that provides the largest amount of food to the food pantry. There will be a banner recognizing the winning entry (walking or float entry).

Honorable Mentions

Given to the entrants that are considered to be outstanding entries within the Parade. Judging factors include conformance to the theme and era selected, creativity, and excellence in design.
