## ORDINANCE NO. 2022-05

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 5 PARKING OF THE JONESBOROUGH MUNICIPAL CODE

**WHEREAS**, the Town has authority to regulate parking within the Town limits in public parking areas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman have determined certain time limits are reasonable and should be made with respect to public parking downtown; and

WHEREAS, the Town finds that an amendment to the current Municipal Code is necessary to effectively regulate parking under the current Code; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF JONESBOROUGH, TENNESSEE THAT:

**SECTION 1**: That Chapter 5, Section 9-504 (14) of the Jonesborough Municipal Code is amended to read as follows: (14) At any place where official signs, which mean any signs placed or erected by the employees of the municipality, prohibit stopping, standing or parking, whether temporary or permanent. The presumption shall be that all installed signs, time limits and parking directions were lawfully installed by the municipality.

**SECTION 2**: This Ordinance shall take affect from and after the date on which it is approved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen and executed by the Mayor and attested to by the Recorder and approved as to form by the Town Attorney as hereinafter set forth.
