- **8 TEAM MAXIMUM LEAGUE.....** This means the first 8 teams to get me the entire packet of the following will be in the league. No exceptions. No holding spots. No incomplete packets. First 8 is it.

### **COMPLETED PACKETS WILL INCLUDE –**

- 1) A completed registration form
- 2) \$250.00 Registration Fee
- 3) COMPLETED and SIGNED Roster of Players
- 4) A copy of EVERYONE'S License &/or Official ID
- 5) A release/use of town property waiver signed by each person on your roster.

**AGAIN.....** not being difficult. Just making it fair to all as well as eliminating any headaches with paperwork. NO INCOMPLETE PACKETS WILL BE ACCEPTED. ONCE I HAVE 8 COMPLETED PACKETS, THE LEAGUE IS FULL. NO ADDITIONAL TEAMS WILL BE ACCEPTED. NO EXCEPTIONS! If you cannot accept this rule, please do not register.

- Teams must have 9 players to begin a game. Males and females must be alternated in the batting order. You must have a minimum of 4 female players to play any game. To help better fill teams, we are allowing teams to play with 6 male and 4 female players. This means your lead-off batter and your final batter will be male, if you choose to play with 4 females. This is the only way 2 males can bat back to back. All 4 female players must play in the field. There will be no restriction to position but they must be on the defensive field of play.
- League play will begin Tuesday, June 20, 2023. Games will be played at 6pm, 7pm and 8pm The end of season tournament will take place around the 2<sup>nd</sup> week in August. Plan on this being held on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday nights. \*\*If you think you will not be playing in the tournament due to playing in another league, please let me know so we can set the brackets for those that will be here.

## **Town of Jonesborough Parks and Recreation Department**

All rules will be per the ASA Rule Book as interpreted by our officials.

Additional rules and guidelines will be followed by all participants:

- Sportsmanship- This is purely a recreational league and inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated from any player, team or spectator. Umpires along with the Town of Jonesborough employees are to enforce a zero tolerance policy. Should someone be ejected from a game, that participant must leave the field site within a reasonable time frame. Failure to do so will result in said participant's team forfeiture of the game.
- Teams are responsible for the actions of their fans. If any fan or team cannot control their behavior, this will result in forfeiture for said team.
- Team mates will wear similar colors if at all possible
- Each team will provide their own bats and balls. All equipment must fall under the ASA standards and be stamped as such. Ball sizes for men shall be 12 inch .52 cor/ 300 compression. Ball sizes for women shall be 11 inch .44 cor / 375 compression
- There will be a 5 - minute grace period for the first game only. There may be extenuating circumstances for the beginning of each game, at this time the clock will start but play will not begin.
- Teams must have 9 players to begin a game. Males and females must be alternated in the batting order. You must have a minimum of 4 female players to play any game. To help better field teams, we are allowing teams to play with 6 male and 4 female players. This means your lead-off batter and your final batter will be male, if you choose to play with 4 females. This is the only way 2 males

can bat back to back. All 4 female players must play in the field. There will be no restriction to position but they must be on the defensive field of play.

- The deadline to add a player to the roster is 24 hours before the first game of the season begins. No other additions will be allowed after. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!!!!**
- If a forfeit occurs, the umpire is not allowed to officiate the game. Once a game is called forfeit, it is a forfeit. If players begin to arrive after a forfeit is called, the game will stand as a forfeit.
- Games are 1 hour time limit or 7 innings. Any game called, due to weather, after the 4<sup>th</sup> inning will be considered a complete game. Any game called, due to weather, before the 4<sup>th</sup> inning, will be rescheduled and will pick up where it left off. The batting line up must be the same. If anyone in the batting lineup is absent, there may be a maximum of 3 substitutions for said absent players, otherwise it will be a forfeit.
- There is a limit of 4 home runs per game. Any home runs that exceed 4 for a team will be counted as an out.
- A courtesy runner is allowed in the event of an injury or injured person. You are allowed 1 courtesy runner per inning per gender.
- Judgment calls cannot be questioned. Again, **ANY** arguing or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- Umpires will not be followed off the field of play. When an umpire walks away they may not be followed. If a player follows an umpire off the field, this will result in a one game suspension for said player.
- All players playing with teams must be listed on the roster submitted to the Jonesborough Parks and Recreation Department. Each team must keep a copy of the roster that is submitted to the department on hand at each game for verification if necessary. However, it is the responsibility of the opposing team to protest an ineligible player. If a protest is made, said player must show proof of identification. If said player is illegal, the game will result in a forfeit.
- It is the responsibility of the team to know the ASA rules as well as the local league rules.
- It is the responsibility of the team to contact the Parks and Recreation Director prior to 4:00pm on the day of games if the team is unable to play. If a team is a no show for 2 games without contacting the department by 4:00pm, the team will not be allowed to play in the league thereafter. Said team will also forfeit the rest of the season games with no refund of entry fee.

- If an umpire or any Jonesborough Parks and Recreation Department employee must clear the fields and the dugouts due to hazardous weather, all participants must do so accordingly. If any participant or team does not adhere to this rule, the said team will declare their game a forfeit.
